

Documents Required to Open Account

Sole Proprietorship

1. Business Filing: In most cases, our staff will find/verify your business filing using online database searches
2. Social Security Number (SSN), Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN), or Employer Identification Number (EIN)
3. Complete an iQ Business signature card at a branch near you
4. Appropriate identification for all signers
5. Signature of all authorized signers – must sign in person or have their signature notarized on the iQ Signature Card

Limited Liability Company

1. Limited Liability Operating Agreement (sometimes called Company Agreement)
2. Proof of registration with the Secretary of State, or we can go online and obtain a copy for you
3. Business Filing: In most cases, our staff will find/verify your business filing using online database searches
4. Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN), Employer Identification Number (EIN), or Social Security Number (SSN) a. TIN or EIN if multiple-member LLC b. SSN for single-member LLC is acceptable
5. Complete an iQ Business signature card and an iQ Resolution of Authority at a branch near you
6. Appropriate identification for all signers
7. Signature of all authorized signers – must sign in person or have their signature notarized on the iQ Signature Card

Partnership - General or Limited

1. Partnership Agreement
2. Proof of registration with the Secretary of State, or we can go online and obtain a copy for you
3. Business Filing: In most cases, our staff will find/verify your business filing using online database searches
4. Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN), or Employer Identification Number (EIN)
5. Complete an iQ Business signature card and an iQ Resolution of Authority at a branch near you
6. Appropriate identification for all signers
7. Signature of all authorized signers – must sign in person or have their signature notarized on the iQ Signature Card

Corporation

1. Corporate Bylaws
2. Articles of Incorporation
3. Proof of registration with the Secretary of State, or we can go online and obtain a copy for you
4. Business Filing: In most cases, our staff will find/verify your business filing using online database searches
5. Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN), or Employer Identification Number (EIN)
6. Complete an iQ Business signature card and an iQ Resolution of Authority at a branch near you
7. Appropriate identification for all signers

Documents Required to Open Account

Association/Club

1. Meeting Minutes
 - a. Outlining in detail who the Authorized Signers for the iQ account will be and their duties
2. Federal Tax Identification Number (TIN), or Employer Identification Number (EIN)
3. Complete an iQ Association/Club signature card and an iQ Resolution of Authority at a branch near you
4. Appropriate identification for all signers
5. Signature of all authorized signers – must sign in person or have their signature notarized on the iQ Signature Card
